Day Rafting Trips

San Miguel River (in partnership with Further Adventures)

***San Miguel Half-Day Adventures**

Come take part in the scenic and winding San Miguel River while you enjoy a float through this pristine habitat with family and friends.

Departure/Arrival: AM-8:00am-12:30pm (Arrival time may vary due to water level)

PM-1:00pm-5:00pm

Included: Transportation, snack, wet suits, booties, spray jacket, PFD

Trip Availability: May 22 through July 26, 2009

-Species Creek to Beaver Creek: 7.5 miles of Class II and III water. Cost \$80 per person

-Deep Creek to Placerville: A Class IV trip for the most athletic and adventurous. Cost \$95 per person

***San Miguel Full-Day Adventures**

If you have the time, a full day float may be perfect for you to get out for a relaxed day trip that leaves plenty of time to take in the beauty of the canyon and river.

-Deep Creek to Beaver Creek Full Day Adventure

Day Rafting Trips cont...

Uncompahgre River (in partnership with RIGS Whitewater)

Come enjoy the scenic Uncompahgre River. The majestic San Juan Mountains fill the back drop for the entire run! Float through prime wildlife habitat for an up-close look at songbirds, deer, and birds of prey!

- “Short n’ Sweet” 2 hour Trip:

Raft the Uncompahgre River from the town of Ridgway to the Ridgway Reservoir on this 2 hour guided raft trip! (Class II and III rapids) Cost \$50.00 per person

- 1/2 Day Uncompahgre Trip:

Experience this untamed section of continuous rapids (class II and III) on the Uncompahgre River! This 9 mile stretch is the perfect choice for those looking for a fun paddle boat run. Cost: \$70 adult \$50 child (6-12 yrs old)

-1/2 Day Uncompahgre Kayak Trip (Inflatable Kayak):

Enjoy the Uncompahgre River between Ridgway and the Ridgway Reservoir. Command your own inflatable kayak or join a TASP volunteer on a tandem kayak. This trip is designed for individuals with prior rafting experience.

-Dominguez Canyon of the Gunnison River Full Day Adventure

Enjoy a guided 1 day kayaking/raft trip through the impressive sandstone walls of Dominguez Canyon. Soak up the surroundings from your raft and/or command your own kayak, while support rafts carry all the amenities for a day on the river. Single person and tandem kayaks are available for this adventure, ideal for novice kayakers. Cost: \$135 per person

Overnight River Trips

-Dominguez Canyon of the Gunnison River Overnight Adventure (with RIGS)

Enjoy a guided 2 day overnight kayaking/raft trip through the impressive sandstone walls of Dominguez Canyon. Soak up the surroundings from your raft and/or command your own kayak, while support rafts carry all the amenities for a night on the river. Single person and tandem kayaks are available for this adventure, ideal for novice kayakers. Cost \$295 per person (2 days/1 night)

Mountain Bike Tours and Road Cycling

Full Day or 1/2 Day Rides (in partnership with Further Adventures)

-Lizard Head to Galloping Goose

This high altitude ride starts with vehicle transport up Lizard Head Pass. The gentle gradient of the Lizard Head Trail rolls down through the alpine paradise with sunny fields of wildflowers and quiet forests of evergreens. Fun for riders of all ages and abilities. Participants must be able to ride independently on beginner to intermediate terrain.

-1/2 Day Telluride Tour with TASP (paved bike path)

This accessible paved trail experience offers beautiful scenery of Telluride and the surrounding majestic San Juan Mountains for mountain bikes and handcycles! A TASP staff member will provide the support you and or your family may need.

Rock Climbing

Full or 1/2 Day Climbing Trips For All Abilities (in partnership with San Juan Outdoor School)

On a full day trip the San Juan Outdoor School along with TASP staff will pick you up at your hotel/residence and take you to the incredible Ophir Valley or destination of choice where we will embark upon an adventurous day into an awesome rock wall canyon. You will learn how to climb, belay and appropriately use technical equipment.

Our half-day trips introduce you to the fundamentals of rock climbing without taking up your whole day. By limiting travel time to and from the crag, we are able to provide you with a chance to have a complete rock climbing experience in a short period of time.

Hiking

Full or Half Day Trail Hiking Adventures (in partnership with the San Juan Outdoor School)

Our full-day adventures are the best way to explore Telluride's backcountry. You will get the chance to travel deep into the San Juan Mountains and explore accessible hidden trails, waterfalls and deep valleys. Opportunities abound to picnic by a trickling stream in a field full of wildflowers.

The best way to acclimatize to Telluride's high altitude environment is to join us for a half-day hike that suits your ability level and desires. Available in the morning or the afternoon, we will take you into one of our region's most beautiful areas for a short walk. Telluride's proximity to beautiful mountains enables you to experience wild places and still be back in town for a café lunch.

Overnight Camping Experiences

Custom Designed Multi Activity/ Overnight Camping Trips (in partnership with the San Juan Outdoor School)

If you are interested in having an overnight wilderness experience join us for a multi day or overnight camp out trip to Alta Lakes, Ridgway State Park, or other numerous beautiful destinations. Trips are custom tailored around the adventure activities of your choice where we will return from a day of rafting, climbing, biking, or hiking to a beautiful campsite for the night. You will have the amenities of home and wonderfully prepared backcountry meals. Roast marshmallows by the fire and listen to the sounds of nature from the comfort of a lawn chair! Most adaptive equipment can be provided for adventure activities and the campsite.

Cost: \$175 per person

If you want to have a camping experience but cannot spare the time to do a multi-day trip, join us for an overnight trip. We will take you to an established campsite, enjoy a tasty backcountry meal, sleep under the stars and head out the next day after a lovely morning in the wilderness. Overnight trips run from noon to noon.

Fishing Trips

Full Day and ½ Day Fishing Trips

Take the opportunity to fish some of the best trout waters in the state right here around Telluride! Choose among numerous destinations from the San Miguel River and the Uncompahgre River to private and high alpine lakes that abound

with beauty and the catch of your dreams. Join TASP guides and either Further Adventures or RIGS Fly fishing for a river float or walk/wade experience that hooks you into an unparalleled Colorado trout fishing experience. Full of half day trips available, all fishing gear included. The purchase of a state fishing license is required.

4x4/Jeep Tours

Full Day Four Wheel Drive/ATV Rides (in partnership with Dave's Mountain Tours)

Experience the magic of the Colorado Rockies on one of our four-wheel drive mountain tours. DMT's knowledgeable guides along with TASP staff will take you to elevations of 12,000 feet and higher on trails in the Uncompahgre and San Juan National Forests. You'll enjoy stunning 360° views stretching all the way to Utah as you travel through open meadows filled with wildflowers. Crystal clear mountain streams, waterfalls and local wildlife are abundant.

We offer a wide variety of tours all around the Telluride region in our 8 passenger, open top 4x4 vehicles. You can enjoy a full day or half day tour or join us for our spectacular 2 hour sunset drive to take in the glorious colors of the San Juan sky from high on the flanks of the mountains.
