## Current TASP Operating Procedures:

### TASP Facilities

- No Indoor student space available
- Limited overnight ski/board storage

### On-Hill / Lesson Structure

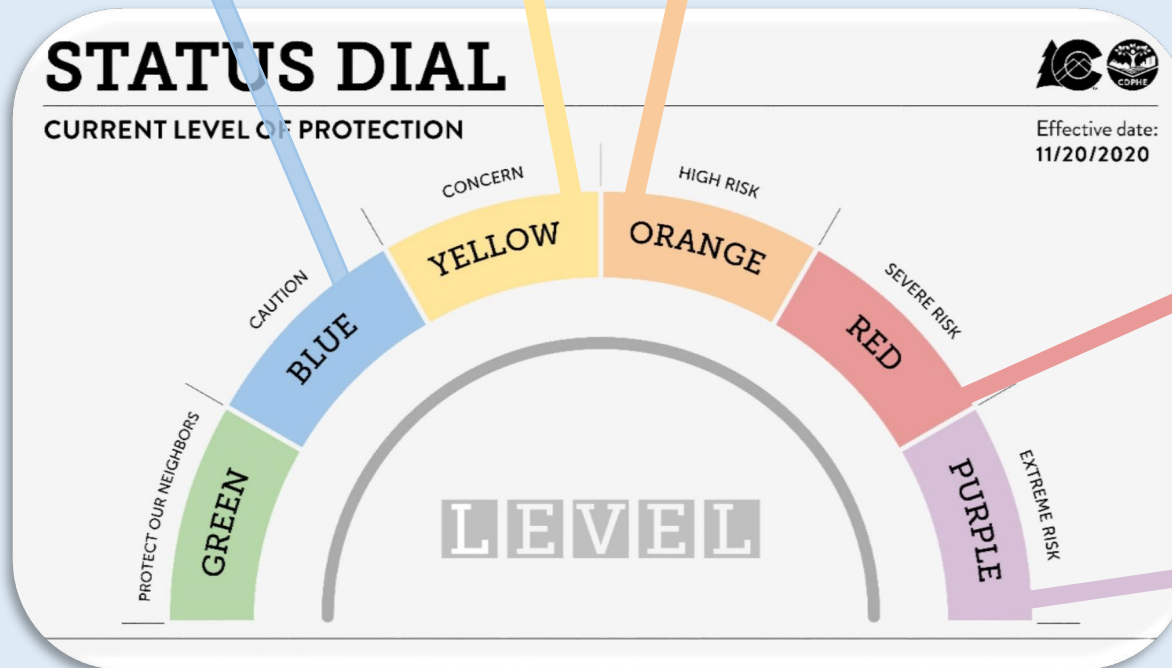
- TASP can provide minimal physical assistance on lessons using strict non-constant touch techniques
- By needs basis use of secondary assistant, role filled by TASP volunteer. One adult family caregiver invited to fill assistant role when appropriate.

### Chairlifts

- No hand-in-hand, arm-to-arm assistance required to get student through the lift line, load or offload the lift
- Clipping of safety equipment executed by instructor but then;
- Able to ride 3 or 4-person chairlift with no physical contact with instructor, leaving one full seat between or adult student rides alone

Regardless of level, *everyone* must:

- Abide by [5 Commitments](#) (masks, distance, etc)
- Complete pre-trip health screening
- Complete day of health screening (for *every* lesson)



**Level Red:**

- In the case of moving to Level Red, TASP will post updated procedures at that time.

**Level Purple:**

- TASP will be closed until further direction is given by San Miguel County Health Department.
